Clinical Information. Findings.

Liver

: Normal in size (13.4 cm; normal up to 14 cm), shape with uniform

parenchymal echotexture. No focal lesion seen.

Gall Bladder : Partially contracted (may be post prandial). A calculus (1.4 cm in diameter) is seen in gall

bladder.

Biliary tree

: Not dilated.

Common

bile duct

: Not dilated (0.3 cm; normal up to 1 cm).

Pancreas

: Normal in size and echotexture.

Spleen

: Normal in size and echotexture.

Kidneys

: Normal in size shape and position. Corticomedullary differentiation is

maintained. No calculi seen. Pelvicalyceal systems are not dilated.

Urinary

Bladder

: Well filled. No intravesical lesion seen. Wall thickness is normal.

Prostate

: Normal in size, shape and normal in echotexture. No focal lesion seen.

No ascites or pleural effusion seen. No enlarged lymph node seen.

Impression: A calculus in gall bladder.
