Clinical diagnosis: Carcinoma splenic flexure of colon (obstructed)

Tissue or organ : Left hemicolectomy specimen

Gross features:

Received in 10% formalin in a container labeled with patient's name, UHID and Lab. Ref. No. is the left hemicolectomy specimen measuring about 20 cm in length. Mesenteric tissue measures 20.0x7.0x1.5cm. There is a stricture in the colon 6.0 cm away from proximal resection margin and 8.0 cm away from distal resection margin. An excavating growth is present here measuring 6.0x3.0cm. A few lymph nodes could be explored from the mesentery. Sections are taken as under:

A1-A6 = Six sections from excavating growth area

A7-A8 = Two sections from other areas

A9-A10 = Two sections from proximal resection margin

A11-A12= Two sections from distal resection margin

B1-B7= Sections from lymph nodes
