

## ULTRASOUND REPORT

- Liver** : Normal in size. Parenchyma is homogenous.  
No definite focal lesion is seen. Portal vein and hepatic veins appear normal.
- Gall Bladder** : Normal in size. Wall thickness is normal. Lumen appears clear.
- Biliary Tree** : Not dilated.
- Pancreas** : Normal in size. Parenchyma is homogenous.  
Pancreatic duct is not dilated.
- Spleen** : Normal in size. Parenchyma appears normal.
- Kidneys** : Both kidneys are normal in size. Cortical echogenicity of both kidneys are normal.  
Cortico-medullary differentiation is maintained. No calculus or hydronephrosis is seen. **One small cyst, measuring about 2.9 cm in diameter is noted in upper part of left kidney.**
- Ureters** : Not dilated.
- Urinary Bladder** : Well filled. Wall thickness is normal. Lumen is clear.
- Prostate** : Normal in size.  
Parenchyma is homogenous.

**IMPRESSION :** Left renal cyst.
