## **ULTRASOUND REPORT**

Liver

: Normal in size. Parenchyma is homogenous.

No definite focal lesion is seen. Portal vein and hepatic veins appear normal.

Gall Bladder

: Normal in size. Wall thickness is normal. Lumen appears clear.

**Biliary Tree** 

: Not dilated.

Pancreas

: Normal in size. Parenchyma is homogenous.

Pancreatic duct is not dilated.

Spleen

: Normal in size. Parenchyma appears normal.

Kidneys

: Both kidneys are normal in size. Cortical echogenicity of both kidneys are normal. Cortico-medullary differentiation is maintained. No calculus or hydronephrosis is

seen. One small cyst, measuring about 2.9 cm in diameter is noted in upper part of

left kidney.

Ureters

: Not dilated.

**Urinary Bladder** 

: Well filled. Wall thickness is normal. Lumen is clear.

Prostate

Normal in size.

Parenchyma is homogenous.

IMPRESSION:

Left renal cyst.
