## ECG:

- · Sinus rhythm no change initially
- ECG today: Wellen syndrome (biphasic T wave in V2-V4)

## CXR:

Normal heart and mediastinum

Lungs appear clear

No pleural effusion or pneumothorax

Impression (conclusion or diagnosis)
Normal chest radiograph

## ECHOCARDIOGRAPHY:

- Normal LV cavity dimensions with normal LV systolic function. Estimated LVEF 62% (Distal anterior WMA)
- Normal LV mass indexed with normal LV diastolic function
- Normal RV
- · Trace MR and TR
- Inadequate TR jet to estimate Pa pressure
- Intact interaterial septum with no evidence of a shunt on Doppler studies
- Normal pericaridum


