USG OF UPPER ABDOMEN (SCREENING)

LIVER:

It is mildly enlarged with hyperechoic parenchyma. No focal SOL is seen. The intrahepatic biliary radicles are not dilated.

PORTAL VEIN:

The portal vein is normal in calibre measuring 1.0 cm at the porta. There is no intraluminal thrombus. No collaterals are seen.

GALL BLADDER:

It is optimally distended. No calculus or sludge is seen within it. The wall is not thickened.

CBD:

The common duct is not dilated measuring 0.24 cm at porta. No intraluminal calculus is seen.

SPLEEN:

It is normal in size measuring 7.4 cm and echogenicity. No focal SOL is seen. The splenoportal axis is patent and is normal in dimensions.

PANCREAS:

It is normal in size and echogenicity. The duct is not dilated. No calcification or focal SOL is seen.
