## USG of Testes / Scrotum

**FINDINGS:**

Right testis measures 4.0 x 2.2 x 1.9 cm, volume: 9.1 cc.  
Left testis measures 4.2 x 2.7 x 1.9 cm, volume: 11.8 cc.  
Right testis is relatively smaller and hypoechoic. Left testis normal in size and echotexture. No evidence of cysts, mass or calcification is seen.  
Right epididymis measures 8.2 mm.  
Left epididymis measures 8.8 mm.  
The epididymis appears normal bilaterally.  
No abnormal fluid collection is seen in the tunica vaginalis on both sides.  
Few anechoic tubular structures are seen in left inguinoscrotal area which may represent mildly dilated Pampiniform plexuses of veins. The diameter of dominant of such tubular structures measures about 3.1 mm and dilates to about 3.4 mm at valsalva. Flow pattern is exaggerated. No reflux is seen.

**IMPRESSION:**

Relatively smaller and hypoechoic right testis - prior H/o epididymo-orchitis.  
Suggestive of left sided grade II hydrocele.
