Note to Dispensing Optician

#### INTER PUPILLARY DISTANCE

1. Dispense the lenses as per the Refractive Power prescribed
2. Dispense lenses as per the Inter Pupillary Distance
3. Dispensed lens material should be UV A & UV B protective
4. Do not dispense lenses with Surface Defects & Internal Imperfections
5. Anti-reflection coated lenses should have Multi coating
6. Eye lenses should not rub against the back surface of the lens

Looking after your spectacles is a vital part of getting the most out of them. It is important to remember that your lenses are precision products that will not give optimum performance if they are damaged or out of alignment!

Below are the Rules:

1. Always use both hands to wear and remove spectacles
2. Whenever spectacles are not in use store them in the case provided to you by the optician
3. To avoid scratching, place spectacles with the lenses facing up
4. Periodically get your spectacles adjusted according to your face
5. At the end of the day rinse the spectacles under running tap water and wipe it dry using dust free, lint free soft material
6. Do not use paper towels, silicone tissues, facial tissues or old rags that may have embedded dirt, which may scratch the lenses
7. Use only Microfiber cloth to wipe the Spectacle lenses
8. You can use a soft tooth brush to clean around nose pads and hinges
9. Avoid using scratched lenses
10. Always wear Eye glasses while driving
11. Please tie this prescription safely for your future reference
12. Ideally get your eyes examined every year
13. If you are allergic to Metal Frames, use only Hypo-allergenic metal frames (Titanium)
14. It is very common to experience a feeling of disorientation while you adjust to your new lenses
15. Never leave your spectacles on the dash board of a car or near a source of heat, as this may distort the frame and can cause the lenses to crack or craze due to excessive heat and extreme temperature variation.

"The prescribing and dispensing of spectacles are very closely linked and it would be in your best interests to have your spectacles dispensed where you have your eyes examined. It is often more difficult to resolve any problems if you have had your spectacles when prescribing and supply are separated".
