COURSE IN HOSPITAL

TAB. GTN SORBITRATE 2.6mg (Glyceryl trinitrate) 1-1-0 till review (after food)

TAB. RAMIPRIL 1.25mg 1-0-0 till review (after breakfast)

TAB PAN 40mg (Pantoprazole) 1-0-0 (20 min before breakfast) for 7 days
