

## GENERAL CARDIAC / GREAT VESSEL / EXTRACARDIAC ANATOMY:

Myocardium: Normal to the extent visualized

Cardiac Chambers:

Left ventricle: Normal Right ventricle: Normal

Left atrium: Normal Right atrium: Normal

Pericardium: Normal to the extent visualized.

Pulmonary veins: Normal to the extent visualized.

Pulmonary arteries: Normal to the extent visualized.

Aorta: Mild atheromatous changes are noted in the aorta.

Lungs: A 2.5 mm sized calcified granuloma in right middle lobe.

Pleura: Normal to the extent visualized.

Mediastinum: Normal to the extent visualized.

Bony cage: Degenerative changes are noted in the spine.

Soft tissue: Normal to the extent visualized.

MEDICATIONS USED: Tab. Alprax: 0.25 mg

**REMARKS:** 

CAD RADS - 45

- Right dominant coronary circulation.
- Patent stent to proximal LAD and distal RCA. No significant in-stent restenosis.
- Up to 60-70% stenosis in proximal RCA and LCx.
