MAGNETIC RESONANCE CHOLANGIO PANCREATOGRAPHY

Imaging Protocol: MRCP was done using 3D – FSE.

**Findings:**

Intra-hepatic biliary channels are not dilated along with right-left hepatic & common hepatic duct.

The common bile duct appears normal in course, caliber and length contains homogeneous intra-luminal fluid signal intensity.

The gallbladder is well opacified and distended.


The pancreatic duct is also visualized on pre fatty meal MRCP.

No abnormal filling defect or dilatation noted in biliary tree.

However ampullary region shows sudden narrowing possibly due to physiological sphincter.

**Impression:** No remarkable abnormality in MRCP findings.
