MRI FISTULOGRAM (PLAIN STUDY)

Sequences: T1, T2 in axial & coronal; T2- Sagittal sequences in 1.5T MRI scanner.

FINDINGS:

- A curvilinear fistulous tract (18 mm) with external opening is noted in right perianal region at 7 O' clock position. The tract is traversing anteriorly superiorly then posteriorly, traversing through intersphincteric plane and finally open at 7 O' clock position ~4.4 mm above the anal verge.
- No supralevator extension of tract is seen.
- Bilateral levator ani muscles are unremarkable.
- No significant pelvic lymphadenopathy is noted.

IMPRESSION:

 MRI FINDINGS ARE SUGGESTIVE OF GRADE I INTERSPHINCTERIC FISTULA AS DESCRIBED. (ACCORDING TO ST. JAMES UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL CLASSIFICATION).
