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MRI OF PROSTATE WITH DYNAMIC CONTRAST STUDY

SEQUENCES USED:

T1W, T2W, STIR - Axial & Coronal T2W, STIR - Sagittal Diffusion - Axial, FL3D (Vibe), FS – Coronal Post contrast T1FS - axial, coronal, sagittal

HISTORY: Elevated PSA

FINDINGS:

Prostate appears enlarged in size otherwise normal in shape, position, outline, signal intensity and contrast enhancement pattern. A focal T2 intermediate to hypointense nodular area seen in the right posterior transition zone measuring approximately 1.8 cm which is iso to hyperintense on STIR, hypo on T1 having early peripheral contrast enhancement with washout visualised on delayed phase having equivocal diffusion restriction that is iso to hypo on diffusion, iso on ADC.

-The residual prostatic tissue is not invading the prostatic capsule with well maintained fat plane with the anteiror part of the rectum is well maintained. Seminal vesicles are visualized normally shoiwing no obvious evidence of any invasion or distension of them.

-Visualized bowel loops are otherwise normal with no obvious collection or free fluid noted in abdomen and pelvis.

-Rest of the visualized bones are normal. No lytic, destructive or sclerotic foci seen. Pre and paravertebral soft tissues are normal.
